Since we renovated the NFCT (which included an expansion of the basement to have a rehearsal room) in 2018, we no longer have to run around the outside of the theatre from the front porch to side staircase to make our entrances on the opposite side of the stage. This is great for the logistics of the show, and less wear and tear on the costumes, but the running around, hurrying to make the entrance on time, made for fun memories!

Over the years, with your support, the NFCT has progressed not only with the renovations on the building and in our theatre technology. It has also progressed to be a hub of activity for a variety of live performances. We are so happy to be able to work with the East End Special Players (EESP) and the Peconic Ballet Foundation this April.
