There was certainly less going on (particularly in the winter) than I was used to, and aside from my family and a few close friends, I didn't really know anyone anymore.

It quickly became clear that I needed something else in my life, something that would provide a sense of community, reconnection, and accomplishment. I didn't know what it was, but it was with this frame of mind that I received news that there was to be a production of Mel Brooks' "The Producers" right here in Mattituck, and they were seeking auditioners.

I did the show. It was challenging, time-consuming, completely foreign to any of my life experiences, and an absolute, rewarding beyond belief, boatload of fun. The show itself was great, but the experience was so much more than just the production. I had discovered this entire community of incredibly talented people who were so passionate about their love of the arts, that they wholeheartedly dedicated their time and energy to uplifting each other, the theater, and the community as a whole.

That sentiment was infectious. Like so many of those around me, I too wanted to use my skills and time to do what I could to support the NFCT and its members. I began to say yes to the group texts or emails that sought volunteers. A clean-up here, a fundraising event there, it didn't really matter what the ongoings were, I agreed to help when I could, knowing that I was going to be with a bunch of incredible people and working together for something bigger than any of us.
